

Patch Test

Doing a patch test can help discern any possible reactions before applying a full application of Solar Essence™. It is recommended for people with sensitive skin and when using a product like Solar Essence™ that may contain essential oils with a higher chance of causing a reaction.

Here are the steps for conducting a patch test for a person with especially sensitive skin:

1. Wash your forearm with unscented soap.
2. Pat dry.
3. Rub a few drops of Solar Essence™ into a small patch of your forearm.
4. Wait 24 hours.

For a less sensitive person that wants to be cautious with essential oils:

1. Apply a few drops of Solar Essence™ to the inner elbow.
2. Wait a few hours to see if there is any redness, itching or rash resulting from using Solar Essence™.

If the skin patch is red, itchy, blistering, or swollen, you have had an adverse reaction to the oil and should discontinue use.

If you experience discomfort before the 24-hour period ends, immediately wash the area with soap and warm water.
